






NEED FOR THE PLAN UPDATE

- State plan feeds into the FAA's National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems (NPIAS)
- Last plan based on data collected in 2001/2002
- Some recommendations in prior plan have been implemented
- Aviation industry and aviation technology have both changed















HOW THE PLAN IS USED BY MODOT

- Gather information that documents current activity, facilities, and services
- Determine how the system has changed since it was last evaluated
- Identify gaps in current system performance
- Establish actions and projects needed to enhance the system
- Estimate investment that will be required to maintain and improve the system


